Rutland Community Ventures Ltd (RCV) is a not-for-profit company limited by guarantee, rooted and based in Rutland where the two founding directors have lived, worked and grown a contact network for a joint total of more than 50 years.

Aim

Strategically our goal is to conceive, develop and action innovative ideas and projects for the benefit of our community. We define our community – but not exclusively – as Eastern England and the East Midlands: Rutland, Leicestershire, Lincolnshire, Nottinghamshire and the major cities in the region.

Objectives

Tactically we:

- receive project ideas and suggestions from community groups, populations, organisations and administrations and develop these into project concepts for which we then find funding;

or we...

- identify/conceive potential projects, share and discuss them with our community and develop these into project concepts for which we then find funding;

or we...

- are commissioned by community groups, populations, organisations and administrations who have identified a need or project following a successful bidding process;

or we...

- work in partnership with community groups, populations, organisations and administrations to bid jointly for project funds from local and national funding bodies.

Our business model is to operate a small central management team and utilise, as far as possible, local freelance and volunteer staff or those with a community connection to operate and deliver project outcomes.
